The Bloomington Civic Association Historic Preservation Committee will present the results of previous Town Hall meetings and outreach efforts. The areas that residents and local businesses have lots of questions and concerns include (1) historic district, (2) permits, and (3) zoning (R-4 that passed July 2015). The questions that residents and local businesses previously asked will be discussed. The Office of Planning and Regulatory Affairs have provided responses to your questions.

There will be breakout sessions in each area to answer questions that you might have that were not asked before. Please come out and let us hear from you. It's important that you let us know how you feel about a

historic district. Is this a designation that you want for your property? Your opinion matters to the BCA. This Saturday Workshop is also being held to allow those that could not previously attend other Town Hall meetings or provide feedback thru other forums held to voice their opinions or talk to BCA Historic Preservation Committee members one-on-one. The Workshop is child-friendly and refreshments will be served.

This is the last major BCA Town Hall meeting to solicit input whole community in this fashion. You ask why? We are now hearing the same concerns, nothing new. However, if you want to coordinate smaller gatherings to discuss more issues that
