## Example Planter Design

Container Width: 33 inches


Overall Plant Height: 1-3 feet

Container Height: 2 feet

## Tall/Medium Height

18 inches tall

12 inch tall and drape up to 3 feet


Draping sedum succulent plants
2 to 6 inches tall and drape up to 2 feet


## Example Planter Design

## Tall Plant - Center

(Red Yucca, Mexican Feather Grass, Little Bluestem, and Blonde Ambition)


## Medium Height Plants

(Big Blue Sea Holly, Catmint, \& Hardy Salvia)


Trailing / Small Filler Plants
(Homestead Purple \& Draping Succulent)



## Planters Specs

- High-tech planters have reservoir, that can hold 8-10 inches of water - means watering once a month is enough!
- Dry surface = less weeds
- Contains overflow chamber so overwatering is hard
- Water will move through the entire plant using filter columns
- Shipping weight is $101 \mathrm{lbs}, 33^{\prime \prime}$ in diameter, 24 " in height
- Planters cost DDOT \$10,000!



## Budget Breakdown

- Soil for 32 Planters - Veteran Compost (15\% discount)
- Top Soil - 2 cubic yards $\$ 66.30$
- Raised Bed Mix - 2 cubic yards $\$ 297.50$
- Labor to fill pots $\$ 75$
- Delivery \$75
- Total $\$ 513.80$
- Plants for 32 Planters (\$45 per planter)
- Total \$1440
- Additional Unanticipated Costs (15\%)
- Total \$293.07
