

Example of Location for Planter









Container Width: 33 inches

2 to 6 inches tall and drape up to 2 feet



Planters Specs


- High-tech planters have reservoir, that can hold 8-10 inches of water - means watering once a month is enough!
- Dry surface = less weeds
- Contains overflow chamber so overwatering is hard
- Water will move through the entire plant using filter columns
- **Shipping weight is 101 lbs**, 33" in diameter, 24" in height
- Planters cost DDOT \$10,000!



Budget Breakdown

- Soil for 32 Planters Veteran Compost (15% discount)
 - o Top Soil 2 cubic yards \$66.30
 - Raised Bed Mix 2 cubic yards \$297.50
 - Labor to fill pots \$75
 - Delivery \$75
 - Total \$513.80
- Plants for 32 Planters (\$45 per planter)
 - o Total \$1440
- Additional Unanticipated Costs (15%)
 - o Total \$293.07

Total: \$2246.87


